REACH

European Union Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 on Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals.

As of December 2008 the deadline for pre-registering chemicals under REACH has passed. We have thoroughly examined our obligations under REACH and can inform that

we are a down-stream user of chemicals and therefore do not have the responsibility to pre-register/register any chemicals. Actually, our production only covers mechanical assembly as we buy finished products/components. This means that we use a minimum of chemicals as a down-stream user.

Regarding Article 33 in the REACH Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 we have the duty to communicate information about the so-called SVHC substances (Substances of Very High Concern) to our customers, if they are contained in our products in a concentration above 0.1% (w/w). We are in constant dialogue with our suppliers on this aspect. We have no information pointing to a content of these SVHC substances in the articles that we supply.

We are aware that new substances will continuously be added to the SVHC list, and we will check with our suppliers whenever new substances are added. We are automatically notified when new substances are added to the SVHC list.

Once a year we follow up on our suppliers ability to comply with the REACH Regulation.

RoHS

Directive 2002/95/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 January 2003 on the restriction on the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

Mita-Teknik being a supplier of monitoring and control systems (category 9 of the categories of Annex 1A of the WEEE Directive) does not sell any products that does not comply with the RoHS Directive.

All new products are manufactured in accordance with the RoHS Directive.

WEEE

Directive 2002/96/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 January 2003 on waste electrical and electronic equipment.

Mita-Teknik is a supplier of monitoring and control systems, which are mentioned as category 9 of the categories of Annex 1A of the WEEE Directive for which the WEEE legislation applies. However, to the best of our knowledge, Mita-Teknik is not obliged to act according to the WEEE directive regarding the distribution of electronic components.

The reason for this is the following:

1. Mita-Teknik is not the first distribution level. Mita-Teknik receives materials from suppliers to make the electronic components that are to be used for the switchboards.
2. Mita-Teknik does not manufacture the functional unit. Mita-Teknik manufactures electronic components to be used in the functional units which are the switchboards.

However, we are aware that at the moment a discussion is going on whether products like Mita-Teknik's are covered by the WEEE directive. At the moment it is therefore unsolved, where in the production chain the producer responsibility begins for this type of products. Mita-Teknik is following this discussion closely and will of course act accordingly, no matter the outcome of the discussion.
